II. Director's Report

- A. Ray Mlada, Chilton High School EBD teacher, came and spoke at the meeting. He has been with the district since 1988. This year he has 24 students in his class, some with significant mental issues. He has 5 paraprofessionals helping him out. His students have done very well this year. 138 "C" level or higher. Attendance was at 93%. He contributes the success to a collaboration with the administration and support staff. Also kudos to Bar-Lev and CESA #7. Mr. Mlada had handouts that showed student profiles and progress reports. He talked about how he has "expectations" rather than "rules" and uses behavior modification. (soda and donut Fridays) There is great support for his students through vocational programs. Six of his seven seniors are going on to school.
- B. Bar-Lev gave an overview of the CDEB program. He talked about the structure and funding. Also showed the county school's student numbers and expenses. The schools included are Brillion, Chilton, New Holstein, Hilbert, and Stockbridge. He also explained the organizational elements of districts within Calumet County. The CDEB origins started in 1974/75 when there was an agreement between Calumet County and CESA #7. There were about 12 other CDEB programs in Wisconsin at that time. There was extensive discussion on CESA and county agreements and taxations. Chairperson Gibler voiced concerns about implementations of programs and parent rights in one district.
