

CALUMET COUNTY TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION MEETING

October 16, 2018

The Calumet County Traffic Safety Commission meeting was called to order on October 16, 2018 at 3:30 p.m. by Brian Glaeser.

Commission Members Present: Chief Deputy Brett Bowe, Brian Glaeser, Rick Olig, Sgt. Andrew Hyer, Rod Hamilton, Jerry Koenig and Levi Gibler

Others Present: None

A motion was made by Koenig, seconded by Gibler, to approve the Agenda for the October 16, 2018 meeting. Motion carried unanimously. A motion was made by Gibler, seconded by Bowe, to approve the Minutes of the July 17, 2018 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Public Participation: None

Committee Member Reports:

Olig gave a Community Maps update and a crash mapping review. Olig stated fatal crash data can be found dating back to 2001 and other traffic crash reports can be found dating back to 2011. Olig demonstrated how to do searches involving roadway factors. Sgt. Hyer stated State Patrol is working on a predictive analytics model for traffic control using the crash mapping. Olig indicated the fatal numbers for crashes for the State of WI is up this year from the five year average.

Hamilton provided information on upcoming road projects:

- Mill and pave USH 10 from STH 32/57 to STH 114 – July through September
- Mill and pave USH 151 from Chilton to HWY 67 – August through September
- CTH LP – four stage project – May through October

Koenig expressed concern with regard to traffic leaving Gravity Park on Hickory Hills Rd. and turning onto HWY 32/57. Bowe indicated that in talking to race coordinators, half of the spectators leave the park westbound on Hickory Hills Rd. and the township has placed a flashing light on the hill to the west of the entrance that can be activated by park employees when race traffic is leaving the event.

Bowe gave information on the traffic fatalities for Calumet County in 2018. Bowe indicated there were three traffic fatalities to date and all three fatalities involved motorcycles.
