**II. Director's Report.**

- A. Nissan introduced Rachel Howell, Calumet County School to Work Transition Coordinator. Rachel described her background, education and previous work experiences. She discussed her upcoming responsibilities and expectations in her new position for Calumet County along with the challenges and uncertainties she will be faced with COVID-19. Rachel's location is at the Brillion high school for the 2020-21 school year.

- C. **CDEB School Reopening Plans:**  
Nissan reported on what the Calumet County School Districts plans are for reopening schools for the 2020-2021 school year. Plans were discussed and reviewed. A flow chart that the Calumet County Health Department prepared for the school districts was shared as to what to do if a student is experiencing any of the symptoms once at school. It was commented what a great resource and support system the Calumet County Health Department has been during these challenging times with a lot of uncertainties and questions.
