How to dispose of tires

Tires have been banned from Wisconsin landfills by the DNR. Tires take up too much space in landfills and can also take methane gases which can start large very dangerous fires. Tires also take more than 50 years to decompose.

There are many uses for old tires including:

- Mulch
- Playground surfaces and equipment
- Asphalt

Tires can also be used to make a tire derived fuel (TDF). It can be used as a substitute for fossil fuel and creates more energy than burning coal.
